The COVID-19 pandemic has brought to light the inequalities that women continue to experience locally and globally.

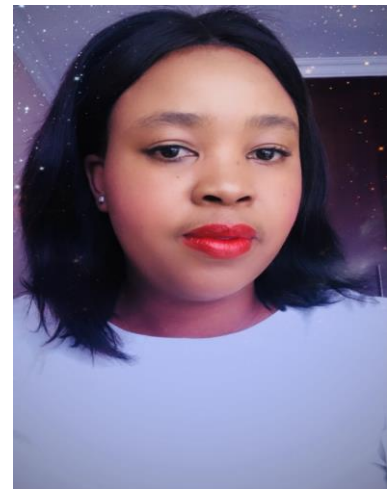
