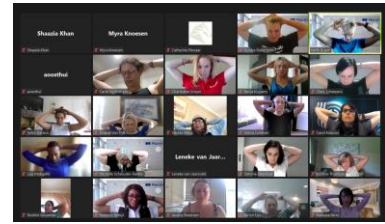

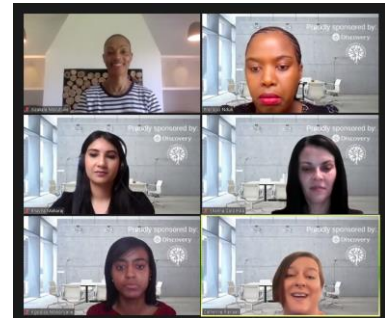
GWII hosts annual Golf Day

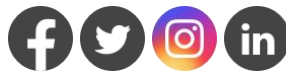
